<u>Literacy</u> This half term, we will be engaging in extended conversations about stories and learning new vocabulary.	<u>Maths</u> This half term we will be focusing on experimenting with our own symbols, marks and numerals. We will also be comparing objects and identifying patterns.		Understanding the World This half term we will be planting seeds and caring for growing plants. We will also be talking about what we have observed using a wide vocabulary and exploring the new season with our senses.		Expressive Art & Design This half term the children will explore colours and colour mixing. We will also focus on developing their listening with increased attention to sound and will explore singing melodies to familiar songs and rhymes. We will also look at joining different materials and exploring their textures.

## <u>Reminders</u>
