




# ***Mrs Vella's Takeaway Homework***

Choose your homework from the menu below. Aim to complete at least 2 pieces of homework each week.

Homework will be set on Google Classroom and should be completed on there - or, if you'd rather complete it on paper, take a photo and upload to Google Classroom to submit. The Peri-ometer suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer. Each week you should try include at least one task from the 'hot' or 'extra hot' spice level.

- Reading is a key part of your child's learning and it is essential you try to read at home as much as possible. There is now a new reading record in your child's reading pack that needs to be filled in every time you read. The new reading record does highlight when children aren't reading regularly at home and as a whole school this is being addressed weekly. **Reading is vital!**
- The new spellings for this half term will be in the homework books. They are a new set of spellings (use the set that your child is with for phonics) for your child to practice over the Autumn 2 term. Please start from week one and work across the 6 weeks. When the spellings have finished after 6 weeks we will be focusing on our nativity songs which I can send out nearer the time.

<p>Look, Cover, Say, Write, Check your weekly spellings. Your spelling list can be found in your spelling and homework books.</p>	<p>Write down 3 unknown words from your reading book and talk about what they mean. Hand your 3 words to Mrs Vella in class and tell her what they mean.</p>	<p>Write a book review about one of your favourite books. Bring it into school for our reading area. A template can be found on Google Classroom</p>	<p>Write some number sentences for addition and subtraction and have a go at working them out e.g</p> <p><math>4 + 3 = ?</math>      <math>9 - 5 = ?</math></p> <p>Use numbers up to 20</p> <p>If you fancy a challenge go up to 50</p>
<p>Play on Numbots, see how many levels you can complete. Your child’s log in details can be found in their reading diary’s.</p> <p><a href="#">Numbots Game</a></p>	<p>Practice all the different phonics sounds on ict games, forest phonics. Try to sound out and spell all the different words. Your children can tell you what sounds they have already covered.</p> <p><a href="#">Forest Phonics</a></p>	<p>Use the Top Marks website to play on the place value basketball game. We use 10 sticks and ones in our maths to help solve our number problems.
