How would the characters act today?</p>	<p><b>Research</b> a female heroine from Lancashire. Write notes about what she did and why she is remembered.</p>

Here is my example:  <i>Leaves are falling down  They crunch under my wet boots  I love to squish them!</i></p>	<p>Recite the <b>4 times tables</b> up to 200 while doing star jumps or clapping each time you say a multiple  Extension challenge: Try to finish in under 2 minutes!</p>	<p>Watch <b>Newsround</b>. <b>Summarise</b> one main report or article in your own words and give your opinion about the news story.</p> 	<p>Read a book and write a <b>book review</b>: What happened? <p>Design and make a <b>Viking shield</b>. Use any materials you like and explain why you chose your design.</p>	<p>Draw a 10 x 10 grid and write down the numbers 1 to 100 (or print one out). Then, colour the <b>Prime Numbers</b>.</p>	<p><b>Day in the Life:</b> Write a diary entry as if you were a <b>Viking or Saxon child</b>. What chores, food, games, or dangers might you face?</p>	<p><b>Pet Poster:</b> Draw 3 pets and label them in <b>French</b>. Write one sentence saying if you have each one or not.</p>
