### PARKING

We have also temporarily suspended whole school assemblies. No other classes have been affected by this. Thank you for remaining vigilant; this really helps limit the impact on you as families and us as a whole school.

## COVID TESTING

If your child has symptoms of COVID (no matter how mild) – please keep them at home and arrange a PCR test.

Lateral Flow Tests are still intended to pick up asymptomatic cases or are to be used when daily testing is required for one week after close contact.
