	<p>Today is the last day that we will be communicating with families via Parent Mail. Thank you to those of you who have already moved over to School Spider. For those who have not yet done so, please see the leaflet attached and download the APP. School Spider will now be the main electronic communication and payment link between families and school.</p>	<p>We are increasingly seeing lots of toys and teddies being brought in to school each day. Please keep these items at home – the last thing we want is children’s precious items being lost or damaged. They can also be a distraction for children when they are learning.</p>	<p>Please remember to pack a balanced diet in packed lunches. Some children are bringing in a significant proportion of crisps, biscuits and cakes as their meal and are then having a post-lunch ‘slump’. Please also remember to halve grapes and cherry tomatoes, especially with the younger children, as they can be a choking hazard.</p>

COVID GUIDANCE	THIS WEEK’S STAR AWARDS!
<p>As you may know, the COVID guidance for England changed on 1st April. From the 1st April, LFD have no longer been available free of charge, and PCR tests are also no longer available in most cases. Children aged 18 and under are advised not to take COVID tests unless directed by a health professional.</p> <p>The list of COVID symptoms has been widened and now includes normal cold symptoms. This means that if your child is unwell you are unlikely to know whether or not they have COVID. If your child has a high temperature or is too unwell to be in school, they should stay at home, whatever the cause of illness.</p> <p>If they are well enough to be in school they should now attend, even if they have, for example, a runny nose, a sore throat or a slight cough. This is back to the guidance in place before March 2020. 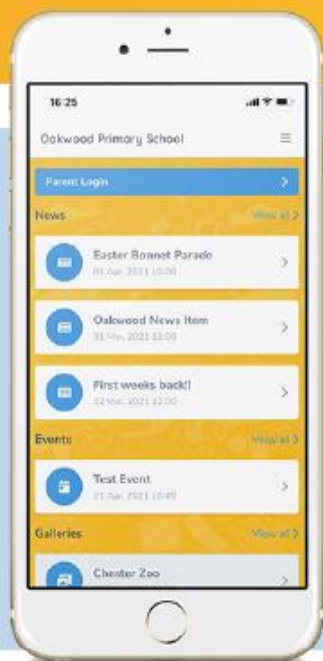
School Spider allows you to receive and return information directly to and from the school. Receive instant messages, complete surveys, book your parents' evenings and make payments.
