UPDATES FROM SCHOOL

- We are well on with improving our reading resources in school. The reorganisation of KS2 home readers is almost complete and our sparkly new EYFS/KS1 home readers and KS2 guided Reading books are being added to our new bookcases as this newsletter is typed! During one of our September inset days, all staff will be receiving training on the teaching and learning opportunities that these new books provide. All these resources will then be ready for the children to access in September.
We will also begin using 'Bug Club' that is an interactive online reading library that all children can use at home and in school. More information regarding this will be shared in September
- Year 6 have been rehearsing their Leaver's Performance this week; they are getting very excited about performing to you all! Next week, each Year 6 child will bring home two tickets – they permit entrance for any of the performances. Tickets are restricted to two per pupil for Health and Safety reasons.
- Building work – as we gradually improve the buildings and environment of Harris Primary School, we are eager to let you know of some planned building works that will take place over the summer holidays. When the children return in September, we look forward to seeing a full refurbishment of the KS1 toilets, improved access for the EYFS toilets, a refurbishment of the internal school entrance hall (to make it a more inviting and useable space) and new main entranceway doors.
- We are currently seeing some children arriving at school as early as 8:15am. For safeguarding reasons, children should not arrive at school until 8:35am, as there is no adult supervision on the playgrounds. The classroom doors open at 8:40am when the school bell rings.
