UPDATES AND REMINDERS

- The EYFS outdoor area is currently undergoing some improvement works. The EYFS Team (and some willing family members!) had kindly volunteered some of their own time to make the area more inviting and purposeful for the children in that class. Please take a look at their fantastic work so far – watch this space for more additions too! Thank you to the EYFS Team and their associated families for all their help with this!
- Thank you for making sure your children refrain from arriving at school before 8:35am. There has been a big improvement this week. It is important that children are not left unsupervised for long periods of time before school. Thank you for your support with this.
- A small number of our Key Stage 2 children order and pay for milk through 'Cool Milk'. We are finding that many of these children no longer wish to have their milk and we are experiencing a lot of waste (and left over milk that has been paid for). We intend to cease the paid milk scheme, in KS2, from September. Instead, we will always ensure that milk is available, to all children, in the lunch hall. If you would like your KS2 child to continue with the milk scheme, please contact the School Office.
- Following tradition, the last day of a full term is non-uniform day! Your child/ren are most welcome to come to school in their own clothes for the cost of £1. All funds received will be donated to The Dog's Trust. This is to show our appreciation for the 'Safety Around Dogs' training that will have been provided, to all our children, free of charge.
- From September, Lancashire Catering Services are increasing the cost of their school lunches slightly. The cost of a school meal will be £2:40 once the children return from their summer break.
- Thank you for all your interest regarding the Sports Cool Holiday Club. Any requests for places that have come in to school have been passed on. We have been informed that anyone who has made a request for a place will be contacted, by Sports Cool' next week.
