- **Year 6 Leaver's Party:** Tonight is our annual Year 6 Leaver's Party. It begins at 5:30pm and will end at 7:30pm. There are lots of exciting activities (and food!) arranged for the children. Thank you to the PTFA and Year 6 Parents who have helped make this such a great event for the children.
- **Lost Property:** Starting from this evening, all lost property will be displayed in the main school entranceway. It will remain there until the end of the day on Tuesday. After this day, any unclaimed items will be either recycled or be added to our Pre-Loved Sale.
- **Pre-Loved Sale:** This week, information was sent via School Spider and Facebook regarding our Pre-Loved Uniform Sale. Good quality, pre-loved uniform will on sale (outside the Year 3 Classroom) before and after school on Thursday and Friday next week. We are also welcoming donations of good quality school uniform. Please take all donations to the Year 3 Classroom by the end of the day on Wednesday 20th July.
- **End of Year Report:** All families should have now received their child/ren's end of year report and have had the opportunity to meet with their child's class teacher if they wished to. A School Spider Form has been sent to enable families to confirm that they have received the report and also to add any comments if they so wish.
- **End of Key Stage Statutory Assessment Information:** Now that all statutory assessment results have been published, moderated and verified, we are able to share these with you. All children in Y2 and Y6 will now have received information regarding their child's attainment scores. Families with children in EYFS will receive their scores on Monday.
- **Extra-Curricular Clubs:** This week is our last week of extra-curricular clubs, with the exception of Players Drama Club who will have their last session on Wednesday. Information regarding the extra-curricular clubs for next academic year will be issued as we return in the Autumn Term.

ANTICIPATED HOT WEATHER

The weather forecast for Monday and Tuesday suggests that the temperature may be unusually high, and a weather warning is in place for most of England. There is still some uncertainty about how hot it will actually be, but we have made preparatory plans for Monday and Tuesday in advance. These include the improvement airflow in classrooms and increased shade outside, availability of more fluids for children to drink and temperature monitoring.

Other contingency plans are in place but final decisions will be made based on the updated weather forecast on the day and the experience of the situation at the time. This may include restricting physical activity in PE lessons and at break / lunch and moving the locations of some lessons. Adjustments will be made wherever necessary.

Children will obviously not be required to wear jumpers over their polo shirts. Please continue to send children in school uniform. Summer dresses are lightweight and school shorts/ skirts and t-shirts will help children remain cool. This will also reduce the risk of sunburn from exposed skin. Trainers may be worn on Monday and Tuesday to help keep feet cool, but for health and safety reasons, sandals and flip flops must not be worn. Please ensure that your child brings a good sized water bottle to school with them, are wearing sun cream and have a hat. They will have the opportunity to refill bottles throughout the day and will be encouraged to drink plenty of water. Our Year 6 children have also arranged another Ice Pop Sale! For £2, every child can have an ice pop 'break' each day. A payment option has been set up on School Spider but we will still accept £2 in cash if required. Our Year 4 children have more information on this which will be sent out via School Spider and Facebook.

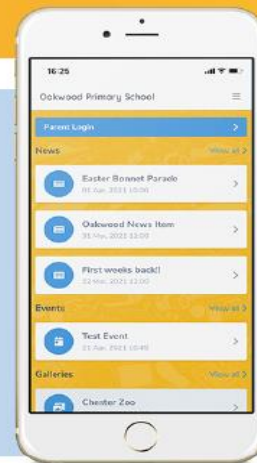
GUIDE TO OUR APP FOR PARENTS & CARERS
